**Thursday 13 Jun 2013**

**Hospitality Room at the DoubleTree Hotel: Located in Rooms 225 and 226**

The hospitality room in the DoubleTree Hotel is open daily beginning Thursday afternoon. Hours of operation are as follows:

Thursday 13 Jun – Opens at 1400 Hrs and closes at 2400 Hrs. The Det 418 mini-reunion will take place in room 225 Thursday evening.

**Golf Outing**

**Wings Over the Rockies Air and Space Museum Tour**

The Wings Over the Rockies Museum Tour will take place on 14 June. The rental bus being used for the museum tour is scheduled to depart the DoubleTree Hotel at 0930 and return to the hotel between noon and 1230. **Please note that this 24-passenger bus is reserved for those alumni and guests who indicated on their registration forms that they needed transportation to the museum.** The bus will take a scenic route through the former Lowry AFB to the museum.

Once at the museum, the alumni and guests can leisurely take in the museum sights at their own pace. The bus will depart the museum at 1130 Hrs. and take a scenic route stopping for an outside look at the old SPINSTRAS and AFTAC Det. 57 buildings, then proceeding past the old Stapleton IAP, which is now a modern residential community, to the former Fitzsimons Army Medical Center which is now home to the massive new University of Colorado Medical Center, Children's Hospital and the new Veteran's Administration Hospital which is under construction. Those alumni who provide their own transportation can pick their own time to visit the museum and see the former base and other places. The museum hours are 1000 to 1700 Hrs. Monday thru Saturday and 1200 to 1700 on Sunday. Admission cost for active duty, veterans, and seniors is \$9.00 payable at the entrance. For information contact Bill Schmied at 303-367-0625.

### **Saturday 15 Jun 2013**

#### **Det 45 Operations Tour, Buckley AFB**

Detachment 45 will be providing operation briefings at 0900 and 1130 on Saturday 15 June. Sign-up sheets for the event are located at the hospitality table in room 226. **Everyone must sign up for a tour time whether you are driving yourself or need transportation.** If you signed up for the Buckley bus transportation the pick-up times at the DoubleTree Hotel are: 0820 to 0830 for the 0900 tour and 1050 to 1100 for the 1130 tour. Transportation will be to Buckley AFB Leadership Development Center where a large group (40 person) briefing will be provided by the detachment. After the briefing groups of 20 people will then be transported in vans to the Restricted Area, given badges and provided a tour of the Detachment 45 restricted area. The vans will then briefly return individuals to the Leadership Development Center. Then the large shuttle bus will return individuals to the DoubleTree Hotel. **Individuals driving their POV should arrive at the Buckley AFB Leadership Development Center Bldg. 1032 ten minutes prior to their tour begin time to receive the briefing and then be transported by van to the Detachment 45 Restricted Area for the tour. Please remember, individuals driving their POV that do not have Military IDs must enter the base at the 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. & Aspen St. main gate which is just east of the BX/Commissary gate on 6<sup>th</sup> Ave at Telluride St.** For information or questions contact Bill Schmied at 303-367-0625.
